

Proposed Amendment
Chapter 91, Animal Services

Amendment to exclude by definition “capuchin monkeys” from the prohibition against keeping “inherently dangerous wild animals.”

Amend first sentence of “Section 91.01 – Definitions” to read:

“Inherently dangerous wild animals: The term applies to the following animals which are inherently dangerous to persons or property and which include: All felines, other than the domestic house cats (including lions, tigers and leopards), nonhuman primates (**except capuchin monkeys**), bears, wolves, coyotes and reptiles (venomous or constricting).”
